

Oral Presentations:

- Please **upload your presentation before the start of your session**. If you'd like to test it, please do so during the breaks.
- The scientific presentations will take place in a large lecture hall at Sportschule Hennef. Please note that the room is over 20 meters long, and the projection screen is not very large. To ensure your slides are readable by everyone, especially those seated at the back, please **use sufficiently large fonts (at least size 20), clear images, and high contrast**.
- Presentations in 16:9 format will best suit the screen, though 4:3 format is also acceptable. We do not require you to change the format of your prepared presentation.
- As our schedule is very tight, we ask that you strictly adhere to your allotted time. Please **aim to leave 3-5 minutes for discussion** at the end of your talk. Session chairs will be instructed to monitor the time, sound a bell, and, if necessary, stop speakers to ensure the schedule runs smoothly.

Poster Presentations:

- Posters should be standard **A0 size**.
- Presentation boards will be available in Room "**Euskirchen**" and the central conference hall ("**Aula**"). Poster boards will be numbered to correspond with your poster's number in the attached conference program and the conference booklet (which will be provided at the reception desk).
- Please ensure **your poster is set up before the start of the conference** (Monday 16.00).
- Posters in Room "Euskirchen" will remain on display throughout the conference.
- Posters in the main conference hall will need to be temporarily moved during the talks and will only be displayed during the designated poster sessions. These posters need to be removed on Wednesday evening, as the hall will be used for the conference party afterwards.

Sporting Activities:

On Wednesday afternoon, we have a 90-minute time window for sporting activities:

- **Indoor Soccer** (on artificial turf) – the – by now - traditional friendly match between PIs and PhD students/postdocs, with mixed teams!
- **Badminton** (up to 4 courts) and **Table Tennis** (6 tables) will also be available in a second hall.
- For those not participating in the sports, we welcome enthusiastic spectators for the soccer teams!
- Rackets and balls will be provided for badminton and table tennis, but please bring appropriate sportswear and especially indoor sports shoes.

How to get to Hennef:

Arrival by Train:

- The Hennef station is accessible via local trains (Regionalexpress or S-Bahn) from **Köln Hauptbahnhof** (~35 minutes), **Köln Messe/Deutz** (~30 minutes), and **Siegburg/Bonn** (6 minutes).
- From Hennef station, take bus lines **516** or **525** and exit at the "**Sportschule**" bus stop.

Arrival by Car:

- From the A3, take the A560 at Autobahnkreuz Bonn/Siegburg towards Altenkirchen. After 2 km, take the Hennef-West exit and follow the signs for "Sportschule" – or simply enter the venue address in your navigation system (see below).
- At the venue, please park in the parking deck. Parking is available for a fee of 5 Euros per 24 hours.
